6. How are you actively waiting on the Lord?
7. Take some time to think about your life currently. What is an aspect of your life that you need to finish well?
8. What big thing is God doing in your life right now?
9. Spend some time thinking about the phrase “I am unfinished.” Finish this phrase, I am unfinished because...
