- Trust His Experiences

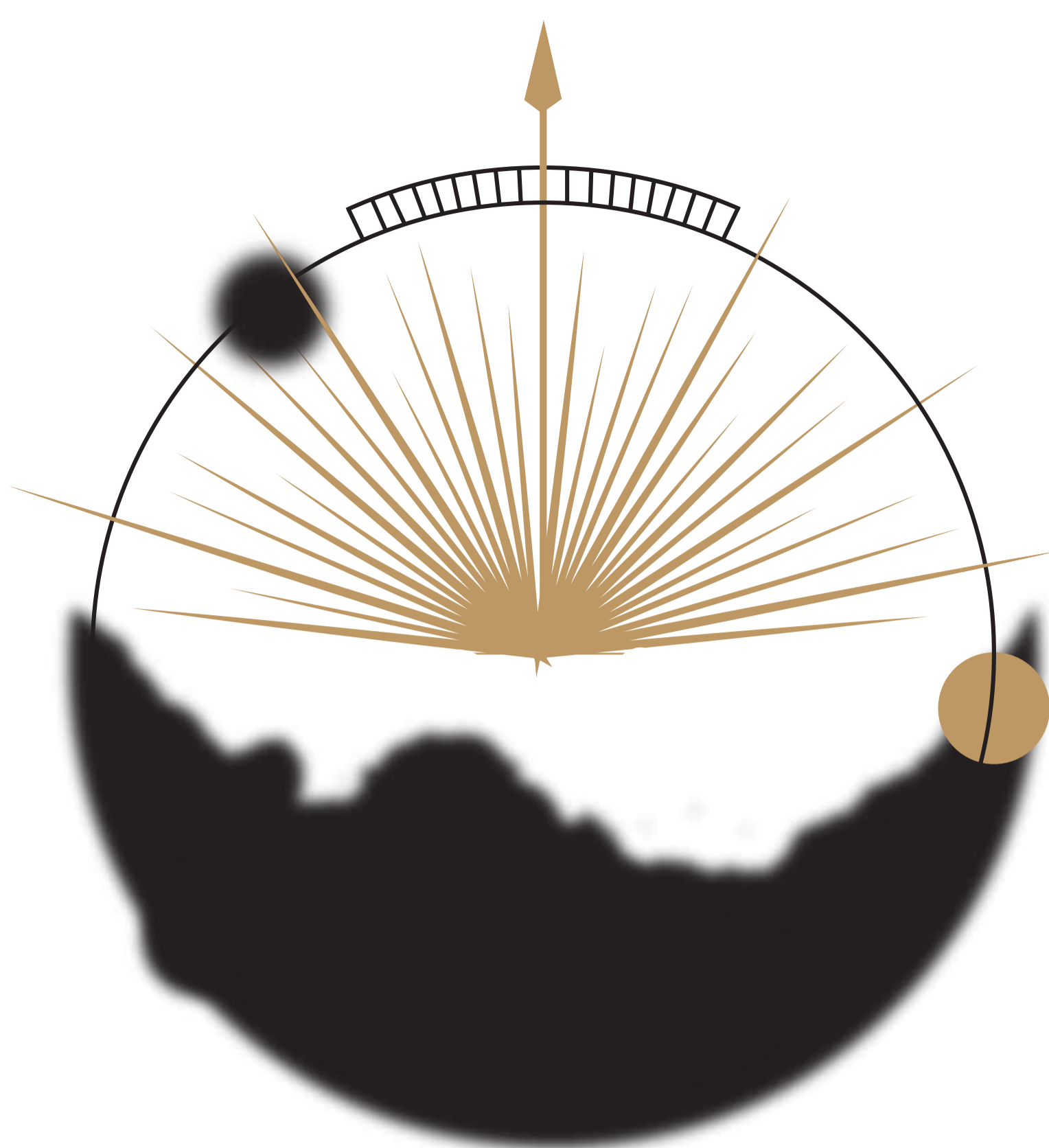
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Spend time re-reading Hebrews 2:1-4. What are the things that the author wants us to remember from chapter 1?
2. What are the witness that the author speaks of in verse 4?
3. In Hebrews 2:5-18 there are many repeating themes, spend time listing all the recurring themes, how do these themes point to Jesus and the Incarnation?
4. What does it mean personally to you that Jesus was tempted so that He can identify with us and help us?
5. How can we be comforted with a God who identifies with us?
6. In what ways does incarnation teach us to respond to the world around us?
7. How can you personally live out the lessons of the incarnation today?
8. Finish this time in prayer asking God to allow Jesus to work through you in your relationships with your friends, family, neighbors, work community, and all other areas you may spend time with people.

DIG DEEPER:

Dig deeper into Hebrews 2:1-18 this week in one of the following ways:

- Read through the Old Testament References Psalm 8, 22, and Isaiah 8. Note the ways they are foretelling the Incarnation.
- Create a list of reasons that make the Incarnation important to you. Share it with a friend.
