

EASTBROOK AT HOME ONLINE HOST

Overview:

The Eastbrook at Home Host serves as the lead pastoral presence for Eastbrook's online platform for worship and discipleship. This position will coordinate and collaborate with other staff and departments for seamless ministry integration for those attending Eastbrook at Home, in order to effectively connect them closer with God and others.

Time Commitment:

Approximately 15 hours/week. Must have ability to work during weekend services (Saturdays and Sundays).

Reports to:

Pastor Jim Caler, Senior Director of Adult Ministries

Responsibilities:

- Oversee online church service in coordination with Worship and Communication ministry teams
- Coordinate details for the weekly stream(s) with Eastbrook at Home streaming team
- Manage volunteer ministries associated with online church service, including greeters and prayer teams
- Create/manage the strategy to move participants of online church service to attend in-person church service or events
- Serve as liaison with pastors and staff of Eastbrook Church to facilitate integration of ministry between Eastbrook at Home and physical locations
- Catalyze research and development of growth edges for Eastbrook at Home and online ministry with other ministry staff
- Attend Eastbrook Church all staff meetings, 2nd and 4th Tuesdays, 9-10:30 AM, relevant department staff meetings, and coordination with staff, as needed.
- Monitor metrics for online church service

Qualities and Qualifications:

- College graduate
- Familiar with and/or adept user of social media platforms
- Familiar with and/or experienced with Church at Home and Resi platforms, preferred but not required

And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.'" (Matthew 28:18-20)

3. Reaching Out

We are aiming to reach beyond ourselves through missional engagement.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." (Acts 1:8)

4. Multiplying Leaders

We are aiming to make leadership growth a priority.

"And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable people who will also be qualified to teach others." (2 Timothy 2:2)

5. Church Engagement

We are aiming to increase levels of engagement at Eastbrook Church, as reflected in attendance, service and giving.

"So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ." (Ephesians 4:11-13)
