Enter by faith asking for mercy (Luke 18:35-43)

"Son of David, have mercy on me."

"Your faith has healed you."

Repent and be changed (Luke 19:1-10)

Welcome Jesus

Demonstrate Repentance

"Today salvation has come." Enter in.

"The Son of Man came to seek and save the lost."

Study Guides

1. If the kingdom is here in our midst, what does it look like? How can we recognize it?
2. Note the contrast: What does it mean to keep my life? What does it mean to lose it?
3. Discuss: How do we strive for maturity while trusting like a child?
4. What does it mean, "Your faith has healed you?" Is physical healing always present with faith? What other kinds of healing are there?
5. How do we demonstrate repentance?
6. How can we live caring for others?
