This Christmas Season, We Need God to Show Up...

...and ______ **Us** (Isaiah 64: 1-4)

- 1. His power is unique
- 2. His power is effective

...and Us (Isaiah 64:5-7)

- 1. Our sin destroys our lives
- 2. Our sin takes us places we don't want to go

...and ______ **Us** (Isaiah 64:8-9)

- 1. God's grace means the forgiveness of our sin
- 2. God's grace means the transformation of our lives

OPEN UP

- 1. Who are you most excited about spending time with this holiday season?
- 2. In preparation for this study ask God to speak to you through your study of the Scripture, and then read Isaiah 64:1-12 aloud.

DIG IN

- 3. What illustrations are used in verses 1 & 2 to illustrate the effect of God's presence? How do you think the world would react to this?
- 4. How would you say the work of God differs from that of other gods (vv 3-4)?
- 5. According to verse 5, why was God angry and what did the people need?
- 6. How are the sins of the people described in verses 6 & 7? What is the point of these images?
- 7. What is Isaiah asking for in verse 9?
- 8. How do verses 10 & 11 describe the destruction in the cities? Why do you think Isaiah points this out?
- 9. What question is asked of God in verse 12?

LIVE IT OUT

- 10. If verse 8 describes your relationship with God, how has He been "shaping" you recently?
- 11. Where do you most need God to show up this holiday season?
