STUDENT MINISTRY WORSHIP COORDINATOR

Overview:

Eastbrook Church believes that one of the keys to a vibrant student ministry is a discipleship-minded Student Ministry Worship Coordinator, whose role it is to seek out youth worship leaders, and help them to develop their gifts and skills for leading worship. Our Student Ministry Worship Coordinator is expected to be a growing disciple of Jesus Christ, who has a vision to make disciples among a diverse body of students from the city of Milwaukee and the surrounding suburbs. The Student Ministry Worship Coordinator should be able to build relationships easily with students, parents, other Student Ministry leaders and members of Eastbrook Church's Worship and Production Staff. Strong teaching skills, creativity, and a pastoral vision are required.

The position is part of the broader NextGen ministry team, and as such, should reflect the broader perspective of curriculum and philosophy of that area. In addition, the Student Ministry Worship Coordinator is expected to create a program that is in keeping with the overall mission of Eastbrook Church and supports the church's vision objectives.

Employment Information:

This position is a part-time, hourly position; approximately 15 hours/week. Must maintain regular (though flexible) office hours as well as have availability on weekends and evenings.

Responsibilities:

- Recruit and develop student musicians, forming one or more teams of Student Ministry worship leaders.
- Schedule and carry out regular Student Ministry worship rehearsals, in compliance with our Child Protection Policy.
- Encourage Student Ministry worship leaders to create song lists and worship sets stored on Planning Center.
- Attend to the technical needs of Student Ministry worship, including creating ProPresenter slides, editing click/backing tracks (or purchasing them), scheduling tech needs for Student Nights and maintaining ongoing communication with Production staff.
- · Communicate ministry vision as well as practical needs to Student Ministry worship leaders and their parents. Facilitate parent involvement, engagement, and communication
- Coordinate vision and plans for worship sets on Student Ministry retreats or other off-campus events.
- Coordinate with Sr. Director of NextGen Ministries on offering a summer Worship Camp for students.
- Participate in the planning, preparation, and execution of Student Ministry events (e.g., winter retreat, leaders' retreat, etc.).
- Perform other duties as a part of the NextGen team and the Eastbrook Church staff.

Qualities and Qualifications:

- Demonstrate a stable, mature, vibrant and growing relationship with Jesus Christ
- Must be an active member or attendee of Eastbrook Church.
- Support Eastbrook Church's Statement of Faith, Mission, Vision Objectives, and Code of Ethics.
- Model servant-leadership by attitude and practice, generous with time and serving with positive, infectious, optimistic attitude.
- Minimal requirement of a bachelor's degree. Youth or worship ministry major preferred.
- Strong musical, leadership, relational, organizational, and teaching skills.
- Must be outgoing, seeking students with musical gifting, and encouraging them toward serving on a worship team.
- Possess working knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, ProPresenter, and Planning Center. Experience using Microsoft Teams, Zoom, and social media apps such as Facebook, Instagram, or TikTok are helpful.
