MIDDLE SCHOOL COORDINATOR

Overview:

Eastbrook Church believes that the middle school years (5th – 8th grades) are a critical bridge from childhood to adolescence. We desire to offer ministry to middle school students and their families that acknowledges their growth and capabilities beyond the childhood basics that they have learned, and offers them ever-increasing depth of study, service, and community. This ministry should include teaching that is differentiated, based on the developmental differences of incoming 5th graders and outgoing 8th graders, and yet promotes common ground in worship, fellowship, and service opportunities.

The Middle School Coordinator is responsible for all aspects of developing a volunteer team, curriculum, parent communication and relationship-building, and teamwork among the NextGen staff team. They will collaborate with elementary-grade coordinators as well as the High School Pastor to ensure a cohesive transition for students as they grown through each developmental stage of NextGen ministry.

Employment Information:

This position is full-time and classified as salaried, exempt; 40-45 hours/week. Maintain regular, though flexible, office hours as well as availability for weekends and evenings. Salary is dependent on experience, skills, and education.

General Responsibilities

Recruiting and Developing a Teaching Team

- Recruit, train, and lead a volunteer team (teachers, small group leaders, etc.) in the operation of Middle School Ministry
- Lead new volunteers through the onboarding process by interviewing, checking references, ensuring their attendance for Child Protection Training and department training
- Train the volunteer team through meetings, regular communication, observation and one-on-one coaching as needed for issues of classroom management, safety and security procedures, spiritual development of middle school ministry.
- Nurture volunteers' spiritual lives by regular communication and encouragement

Maintaining a Nurturing Environment

- Implement age-appropriate, theologically sound curriculum for Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings. This includes a special unit on the Believe FaithMarker for 6th grade students.
- Maintain classroom supplies
- Communicate building/room needs with EBA staff and other Eastbrook NextGen team members

Building Relationships with Parents

- Communicate regularly with parents through email, calls, church-wide announcements
- Welcome and greet new parents
- Encourage parental involvement in special events and retreats
- Respond to individual parents' needs concerning their child

Summer Camps and Other Activities

- Lead VBS Crew, through recruiting, training, and leading middle school students
- Along with VBS Coordinators, Lead Crew members through devotions, training, and specific VBS tasks
- Collaborate with Camp Director on the inclusion of camps for Middle School Students
- Work with Director, Student Ministries in planning and implementing retreats, trips, and other events

Teamwork

- Maintain healthy collaborations with the whole NextGen team
- Attend and support key NextGen and all-church events (e.g., Advent Night, Summer Camp, Baptisms, Leader Launch, etc.)
- Assist in the development of an annual budget for Middle School (as part of overall Student Ministry budget), manage ministry spending accordingly.



Qualities and Qualifications:

- Must demonstrate a mature, vibrant and growing relationship with Jesus Christ
- Must be an active member or attendee of Eastbrook Church. Must support Eastbrook Church's Statement of Faith, Mission, Vision Objectives, and Code of Ethics.
- Must possess at least two years of experience in working with middle school students (staff or volunteer positions)
- Must possess a minimum of bachelor's degree in education or youth ministry
- Must have strong leadership, organizational, communication and teaching skills. Must be creative in event planning and curriculum adaptation.
- Must be skilled in classroom management.
- Must possess working knowledge of Microsoft Word. Experience using Microsoft Teams, Excel, PowerPoint, Zoom, and social media platforms is beneficial.
