Overview:

Eastbrook Church has a rich history of empowering our members to reach out to our city and world. Locally this has grown to be our focus ministries of the Food Pantry. Bread of Healing Clinic, Safe Families, International Community Center, and International Student Outreach. Internationally this has focused on sending field workers and partnering with national workers to reach the unreached parts of the world, particularly the Horn of Africa, Middle East, and Asia.

Intentional coordination is essential to maintain a cohesive and vibrant missions ministry. The purpose of this position is to support our members and ministries as we continue to reach out to our city and world.

Employment Information:

This is a full-time, exempt, salaried position; Must maintain regular (though flexible) office hours as well as Sunday mornings and occasional weekend or evening hours. Salary is dependent on experience, skills, and education.

Responsibilities:

- Prayer. Coordinate the sharing of prayer requests from Eastbrook local outreach ministries and international workers through Eastbrook Prays, Missions Prayer Class, Missions Corner, etc.
- Mobilize. Support local and international outreach efforts by coordinating the dissemination of mission opportunities through Connect, Grow Serve, the Serve Email, the Database, etc.
- Equip. Maintain the mission resource list and library. Serve on the Perspectives coordinating team and Urbana preparation team. Assist in coordinating other seminars and classes.
- Care. Support and resource the Care Teams for Eastbrook international workers, including connecting new members to existing care teams.
- Events. Collaborate with staff and leaders to implement the annual MissionsFest, Ready-Set-Go, Global Summit, City Summit, and Members Reaching Out events.
- Serve. Participate in each local outreach ministry on a monthly basis to have experience and insight as to how best to integrate the above tasks to support each ministry. Manage specific projects related to strengthening local outreach efforts.
- Go. Support Eastbrook Short Term Trips and their leaders. If needed, serve as a trip leader. Participate in one short term or worker care trip per year.
- Administrative. Coordinate other details as needed such as grant administration, relief funds distribution, local outreach annual assessment administration, and worker care info gathering.

Qualities and Qualifications:

- Must demonstrate a mature, vibrant, and growing relationship with Jesus Christ and support Eastbrook's Statement of Faith and Code of Conduct.
- Familiarity with Eastbrook Church, the nature of the congregation, its vision, and core values.
- Must have 2+ years of experience in local or international outreach (both is preferred).
- Bachelor's Degree preferred, but depends on demonstrated experience in outreach.
- Must have strong coordination, organizational, communication and collaboration skills.
- Must possess proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint or similar platforms.
