FACILITIES SPECIALIST

Overview:

The Facilities Specialist role involves troubleshooting, performing minor repairs, responding to emergency calls for service, and performing scheduled ground maintenance depending on the season. Works closely with staff and the public to meet their ministry needs and resolves problems to ensure efficient and safe operations. This is a cross-functional position that assists with lighting maintenance, minor plumbing repairs, painting, demolition, product inventory, renovations, landscape projects, and custodial tasks as necessary to support daily operations.

This position is full-time, hourly, and non-exempt. Must maintain regular office hours and occasional weekend or evening hours. Specific scheduling of hours defined by supervisor. Salary is dependent on experience and skills.

Responsibilities:

- Respond to maintenance requests from staff and ministry leaders in a timely manner.
- Troubleshoot and diagnose issues with electrical, mechanical, and plumbing systems.
- Ensure compliance with safety regulations and maintain a safe working environment.
- Maintain accurate electronic records of maintenance activities.
- Assist with supervising routine maintenance and inspections.
- Coordinate and supervise contractors for repairs and improvement projects as needed
- Coordinate and contribute to various remodeling projects as requested.
- Work hands on completing minor repairs involving electrical, mechanical, plumbing and various tasks.
- Direct the work of volunteer assistants as needed
- Assist, as needed, as a part of security response team.
- Assist, as needed, with custodial efforts.

- Work safely with and knowledge of proper use, handling and disposal of pesticides and a wide range of chemicals according to state and federal regulations
- Ability to perform physical activities such as, but not limited to, lifting heavy items (up to 50 lbs. unassisted), bending, standing, climbing or walking.
- Able to work under inclement weather conditions.
- Knowledge of methods of boiler maintenance, plumbing, and electricity is a plus.
- Possess a valid (Class D) Wisconsin driver's license with an acceptable driving record.
- Possess current CPR and first aid training.
- Possess a combination of education and experience that provides the required knowledge and ability.
