

KIDS' PRAYER SCAVENGER HUNT









WHAT TO BRING:

- **Comfy shoes** for walking!
 - As you put them on, think about Psalm 119:105, which says that "[God's] word is a lamp for my feet and a light on my path." While you pray today, remember that God shows us the way!
- A **pencil** and your **scavenger hunt paper**
- Optional: a **clipboard** to write on

WHAT TO DO:

- **Look** for the items on the list on the back of this paper.
- **Tell God** about what you see! You can thank Him, ask for His help, or just talk to Him about what you are noticing.
- **Check** the items off the list as you pray about them.
 - Pay attention to the people and places you walk past! If you see something that's not on the list that you want to pray about, you can add it in the blank space.
- When you get home, **draw** a picture of one thing from your prayer walk that you can pray for again this week.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thank God for the people in the car. • Ask God to protect them as they drive and to show them His love.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thank God for giving us places to praise Him together! • Ask God to show us how to love others like He loves them.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thank God for people who do hard work, and for the ways God also fixes what feels broken in our lives..
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thank God for animals and all the things He's made. • Ask God to provide friends for people in your neighborhood who are lonely.
