FOR THE CHURCH

JUNE
1-6

Pray for all those taking the step of Baptism on June 7. This is an exciting moment for them all to proclaim their faith in Jesus and declare they want to be known as His disciples! Pray for them to continue to find ways to grow in their journey with God. // Pray for our summer interns as they join us to explore their calling in ministry. Ask God to work in their hearts and guide them towards deeper knowledge of Him.

JUNE
21-30

Praise God for the new lives He has brought into our church family! Pray for parents to rely on God's Word and His wisdom as they nurture their children. Pray that the children themselves will grow to love Jesus. // Pray for our Small Groups and Bible Studies happening this summer. Pray people will have fun times together where they can connect and grow socially as well as in their understanding of God's Word.

FOR THE CITY

Praise God for His work through the Eastbrook Food Pantry. Pray that He would continue to provide enough volunteers to meet the demand and fill each one with the Holy Spirit to serve in His strength, not their own. Pray that every guest would feel seen by God this month through a warm welcome, caring conversation, or a special food item provided just for them by their heavenly Father.

Pray for the Bread of Healing Clinic at Eastbrook. Ask God to give wisdom and discernment to the staff and volunteers as they care for patients. Pray for patients facing difficult circumstances or feeling overwhelmed by health concerns, that Jesus would meet them, provide for them, and give them rest. Pray that the clinic would shine as a light in the darkness for all who come.

Pray for the International Community Center and the work God is doing there. Pray for those adjusting to new lives in America, especially single mothers and those separated from family. Pray for Gregg and Rawda as they run a school in the Holy Land. Praise God for continuing in-person classes despite unrest in the region. Pray for a peaceful solution to the current conflict and for peace in the hearts of people who live there. Pray that they would be able to complete the academic year without disruptions, for qualified teachers to fill vacant positions, and for success in completing their construction work this summer.

Pray for Zach as he reaches out in Japan to those who do not know Jesus. Pray for wisdom in his friendships and discernment in what to say and when. Praise God for the new community with a shared heart for outreach and discipleship. Pray for growing partnership there and unity in the Body of Christ in Japan. Pray for a sweet and restful time as he visits Milwaukee this summer.

“Do not mistreat or oppress a foreigner, for you were foreigners in Egypt. I am the LORD your God.” (Exodus 22:21) Pray for those displaced from their homes and living in foreign lands.
